The Certified Financial Planner Certification Education program teaches the core curriculum necessary to meet the educational requirement to sit for the CFP Certification Examination, including completion of a financial plan development (capstone) course registered with the CFP Board. To become certified, the CFP Board requires you to meet the following four initial certification requirements: education, examination, experience and ethics. After successful completion of the program, earn a Rice Certificate of Achievement.
